18           WHEREAS, An avid baseball fan, Mrs. Fabiano enjoyed cheering for her favorite team,  
19 the New York Yankees. She was a fabulous baker and cook, specializing in La Vagilia on  
20 Christmas Eve. She also loved to shop and read, delighted in everything chocolate, and all things
