It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 46-23-4 of the General Laws in Chapter 46-23 entitled "Coastal
- 2 Resources Management Council" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>46-23-4. Officers of the council Quorum and vote required for action.</u>
- 4 The governor shall select from the appointed members a chairperson and vice chairperson.
- 5 The council shall thereupon select a secretary from among its membership or staff. The council
- 6 may engage staff, including legal counsel, as it deems necessary. A quorum shall consist of six (6)
- 7 members of the council. A majority vote of those present shall be required for action, except that a
- 8 super majority of three-fifths (3/5) of the duly appointed council is required to override a
- 9 <u>recommendation by the CRMC staff.</u>
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
