WHEREAS, Rhode Island's 2022-23 fiscal year ended with a surplus of more than \$600

5 million; now, therefore be it

of properly authenticated vouchers.

RESOLVED, That there is hereby appropriated, out of the surplus funds in the treasury not otherwise appropriated from the fiscal year 2022-2023, the sum of one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) to The Office of Energy Resources to review and approve grants in the amount of up two thousand dollars (\$2,000) per expected kilowatt generated for solar canopy (or solar carport) projects that are designed to generate fifty kilowatts (50kw)or greater; and the state controller is hereby authorized and directed to draw his orders upon the general treasurer for the payment of said sum, or so much thereof as may be from time to time required, upon receipt
