2 formaldehyde, benzine, fine particulate matter and smog forming chemicals which can cause 3 dizziness, headaches, asthma attacks, heart and lung disease, cancer and dementia; and WHEREAS, In addition, Gas powered leaf blowers generate noise at a decibel level 4 5 capable of causing hearing loss in a short amount of time; and WHEREAS, Rhode Island's 2022-23 fiscal year ended with a surplus of more than \$600 6 million; now, therefore be it 7 RESOLVED, That there is hereby appropriated, out of the surplus funds in the treasury 8 9 not otherwise appropriated for the fiscal year 2022-2023, the sum of one million dollars 10 (\$1,000,000) to The Office of Energy Resources to provide a maximum of \$250,000 per city or 11 town, to fund a rebate program in conjunction with the passage of an eligible ordinance that 12 would ban the use of gasoline-powered leaf blowers and said refund would be implemented 13 within two years of passage of the ban, with any unused funds returned to the state general fund 14 after one year of implementation of the program and subject to refund to the State if the ordinance 15 is repealed; and the state controller is hereby authorized and directed to draw his orders upon the

general treasurer for the payment of said sum, or so much thereof as may be from time to time
