It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 40-8 of the General Laws entitled "Medical Assistance" is hereby
- 2 amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>40-8-33. Graduate student services covered.</u>
- 4 Notwithstanding any general law, public law, special law, rule or regulation to the contrary,
- 5 Medicaid reimbursement shall be provided under this chapter for services provided by a graduate
- 6 student intern in one of the mental health professional disciplines who is formally assigned by an
- 7 accredited college/university to an agency or facility for clinical training. The graduate student
- 8 intern shall be allowed to receive compensation from these reimbursed hours and the supervising
- 9 organization is allowed to retain a portion of the compensation to cover expenses related to
- 10 supervisory work. A mental health practitioner working as a clinical trainee must:
- 11 (1) Comply with requirements for licensure or board certification as a mental health
- 12 professional including supervised practice in the delivery of mental health services for the treatment
- 13 of mental illness; or
- 14 (2) Be a graduate student in a bona fide field placement or internship under a program
- 15 <u>leading to completion of the requirements for licensure as a mental health professional.</u>

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

2 a supervisory protocol would be eligible to be paid from Medicaid reimbursement.
