## RELATING TO PROPERTY -- RESIDENTIAL LANDLORD AND TENANT ACT

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 34-18 of the General Laws entitled "Residential Landlord and Tenant
- 2 Act" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 34-18-58. Sealing and unsealing of court files.
- 4 (a) Actions arising under §§ 34-18-35, 34-18-36, and 34-18-38 may be sealed by the court
- 5 upon motion by any party or parties after the conclusion of the case.
- 6 (b) In ruling on the motion to seal, the court shall consider the disposition of the case,
- including, but not limited to, whether the case was dismissed, whether rent claimed in the case has 7
- 8 been paid through a rental assistance program, and if the case was resolved by stipulation whether
- 9 the terms of the stipulation have been fulfilled by the parties.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January 1, 2024. 10
