It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5-65-7 of the General Laws in Chapter 5-65 entitled "Contractors'

Registration and Licensing Board" is hereby amended to read as follows:

5-65-7. Insurance required of contractors.

- 4 (a) Throughout the period of registration, the contractor shall have in effect errors and 5 omissions insurance, public liability and property damage insurance covering the work of that
- contractor that shall be subject to this chapter in not less than the following amount: five hundred 6
- thousand dollars (\$500,000) combined single limit, bodily injury and property damage. 7
- 8 (b) In addition, all contractors shall have in effect workers' compensation insurance as
- 9 required under chapter 29 of title 28. Failure to maintain required insurance shall not preclude
- 10 claims from being filed against a contractor.
- 11 (c) The contractor shall provide satisfactory evidence to the board at the time of registration
- 12 and renewal that the insurance required by subsections (a) and (b) of this section has been procured
- 13 and is in effect. Failure to maintain insurance shall invalidate registration and may result in a fine
- 14 to the registrant and/or suspension or revocation of the registration.
- 15 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
