It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 36-1 of the General Laws entitled "Appointment, Qualification, and
- 2 Tenure of Officers" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>36-1-4.1. Deliveries of letters of appointment to secretary of state.</u>
- 4 (a) Every appointing authority under this chapter, including, but not limited to the
- 5 governor, shall, within thirty (30) days after any appointment authorized by the general laws,
- 6 deliver to the secretary of state any letters of appointment, reappointment, replacement and
- 7 <u>resignation.</u>
- 8 (b) Public bodies subject to this chapter shall be provided a one-year time period
- 9 commencing upon the passage of this section to reaffirm their membership.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
