It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 23-3 of the General Laws entitled "Vital Records" is hereby amended
- 2 by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>23-3-25.2. Incarcerated persons' exemption for fees for copies and searches.</u>
- 4 Any incarcerated person who is set to be released from prison to re-enter the community
- 5 shall be processed without a charge or fee when making a first request for vital statistics at the
- 6 <u>department of health regarding a request for their own personal records.</u>
- 7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
