SECTION 1. Section 45-2-35.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 45-2 entitled "General

2 Powers" is hereby amended to read as follows:

#### 45-2-35.1. City of Newport — Landing and boarding fees.

- 4 (a) The city of Newport is authorized to charge, assess, or otherwise collect from every
- 5 cruise vessel landing at a dock in the city of Newport a landing fee of three dollars (\$3.00) ten
- 6 <u>dollars (\$10.00)</u> per passenger and from every cruise vessel embarking from <u>a dock Newport</u>, a
- 7 boarding fee of three dollars (\$3.00) ten dollars (\$10.00) per passenger. For the purposes of this
- 8 section, the term "cruise vessel" does not include ferries and water carriers of persons and/or
- 9 property doing business as common carriers operating upon waters between termini within the

- (b) The city council of the City of Newport shall promulgate rules and regulations to
- implement the provisions of this section.
- 13 (c) The city of Newport is authorized to impose a penalty on any delinquency in the
- payment of any fee imposed under this section, at a rate equal to that assessed by the city on tax
- 15 delinquencies.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
