It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 31-3-48.2 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-3 entitled "Registration of Vehicles" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 31-3-48.2. Plates for recipients of the Bronze Star Medal.
- 4 (a) The administrator of the division of motor vehicles is empowered to make available to
- 5 recipients of the United States Bronze Star Medal a special motor vehicle registration plate for any
- 6 motor vehicle eligible for registration as an automobile or commercial vehicle having a gross
- 7 weight of twelve thousand pounds (12,000 lbs.) or less, indicating the owner as a recipient of the
- 8 Bronze Star Medal. The applicant shall be required to pay a registration fee and a transfer charge
- 9 of five dollars (\$5.00) for the plate.
- (b) The plate shall contain the words "Bronze Star Medal" across the top of the plate, shall
   bear an insignia for the Bronze Star Medal, and then a numeral or numerals.
- 12 (c) Upon the death of the holder of any "Bronze Star Medal" plate, the plate shall be
- transferred to the surviving spouse for the spouse's lifetime or until remarriage.
- 14 (d) The applicant shall not be required to pay a registration fee or service charge for the
- plates.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January 1, 2026.
