It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 16-38 of the General Laws entitled "Offenses Pertaining to Schools
- 2 [See Title 16 Chapter 97 The Rhode Island Board of Education Act]" is hereby amended by
- 3 adding thereto the following section:
 - 16-38-15. Legacy admissions.
- 5 (a) No public or private university shall extend preferential treatment to an applicant in any
- 6 manner because of the student's familial relationship to a previous attendee during admissions
- 7 <u>consideration</u>.

- 8 (b) No public or private university shall inquire about a prospective student's familial
- 9 relationship to a previous attendee on an application for admission. If the university learns about
- 10 the prospective student's familial relationship to a previous attendee during the application process,
- the institution shall not extend preferential treatment to the prospective student.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
