It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 5-19.1 of the General Laws entitled "Pharmacies" is hereby amended
- 2 by adding thereto the following section:
  - 5-19.1-37. Continuation of therapy prescription refill.
- 4 (a) In the event a pharmacist receives a request for a prescription refill, and the pharmacist
- 5 is unable to readily obtain refill authorization from the prescriber, or the patient does not have a
- 6 prescriber, the pharmacist may dispense a one-time refill for continuation of therapy, up to, but no
- 7 more than one hundred (100) days of the prescribed medication provided that:
- 8 (1) The prescription is not for a drug in Schedule II-V appearing in chapter 28 of title 21
- 9 ("uniform controlled substances act");
- 10 (2) The medication is essential to the maintenance of life or to the continuation of therapy
- 11 of a chronic condition;

- 12 (3) In the pharmacist's professional judgment, the interruption of therapy might reasonably
- 13 produce undesirable health consequences or may cause physical or mental discomfort; and
- 14 (4) The dispensing pharmacist notifies the prescriber of the dispensing within seven (7)
- 15 <u>business days. If no current prescriber exists, the pharmacist shall document such in their internal</u>
- 16 record keeping system.
