It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 39-1 of the General Laws entitled "Public Utilities Commission" is
- 2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 **39-1-64. Cap on energy distribution fees.**

- 4 (a) Notwithstanding any provisions of the general laws to the contrary, any public utility
- 5 as defined in § 39-1-2 shall not increase the transmission and distribution fees paid by the consumer
- 6 on a billing statement for a period of two (2) years commencing July 1, 2025, unless the increase
- 7 <u>is approved by affirmative action of the general assembly.</u>
- 8 (b) The provisions of this section shall not apply to a utility having fewer than seven
- 9 thousand five hundred (7,500) utility accounts.
- 10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

- 1 This act would mandate any utility provider from increasing the transmission and
- 2 distribution fees paid by a consumer for a period of two (2) years.
