It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 31-27-4 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-27 entitled "Motor
- 2 Vehicle Offenses" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 31-27-4. Reckless driving and other offenses against public safety.
- 4 Any person who operates a motor vehicle recklessly so that the lives or safety of the public
- 5 might be endangered, or operates a vehicle in an attempt to elude or flee from a traffic officer or
- police vehicle, shall be guilty of: a misdemeanor for the first conviction and a felony for the second 6
- 7 and each subsequent conviction.
- 8 (1) A misdemeanor for the first conviction; and
- 9 (2) A felony for the second and each subsequent conviction.
- 10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
