It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 39-3 of the General Laws entitled "Regulatory Powers of 2 Administration" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section: 3 39-3-37.4. Electric and gas meter reading required quarterly. 4 (a) Every electric and natural gas distribution public utility shall read, record and update 5 utility billing on quarterly scheduled intervals. Bills shall be forwarded promptly. 6 (b) A utility company which estimates bills shall file with the PUC a current, simple, clear 7 and concise statement of their formula used in preparing estimated bills. 8 (1) Estimated bills for ratepayers shall consist of charges for utility services calculated in 9 accordance with the formula approved by the PUC. 10 (2) Estimated bills may be submitted to ratepayers for months when the quarterly reading is not scheduled or conducted. 11 (c) In the event the utility fails to read the meter on a quarterly basis, they shall not demand, 12 13 collect or require payment of any balance in excess of the amount required by the prior estimated 14 monthly bills. Any amount otherwise due for use in excess of the estimated monthly bill shall be 15 forfeited for any period in which the electric or natural gas distribution utility failed to read the

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC UTILITIES AND CARRIERS -- REGULATORY POWERS OF ADMINISTRATION

This act would require a natural gas and electric utility company to read the meters of all ratepayers on a quarterly basis. The utility would be required to provide a formula, used to create estimated bills, to the PUC in order to send estimated bills.
