It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 21-28.9 of the General Laws entitled "The Good Samaritan Overdose
- 2 Prevention Act of 2016" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 21-28.9-6. Training to administer opioid antagonists.
- 4 All lifeguards, and park and forest rangers, employed to work in any state or municipal
- 5 public beach or facility shall be trained in the administration of opioid antagonists, pursuant to the
- 6 provisions of this chapter. All state or municipal public beaches and facilities, that employ
- 7 lifeguards, and park and forest rangers, shall maintain and provide a minimum of four (4) doses of
- 8 the opioid antagonist.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
