JOINT RESOLUTION

CREATING A SPECIAL LEGISLATIVE COMMISSION TO STUDY BLOCKCHAIN AND CRYPTOCURRENCY

Introduced By: Senators DiPalma, Bell, Burke, Gu, and Murray

Referred To: Senate Artificial Intelligence & Emerging Tech

WHEREAS, Cryptocurrency is a medium of exchange that has a monetary value as is the 1 2 US dollar; and WHEREAS, Blockchain is a storage technology used for saving data on decentralized 3 4 networks; and 5 WHEREAS, A blockchain records and confirms cryptocurrency trades, much like a digital ledger, and collects and stores the information when a person buys, sells, or exchanges 6 7 cryptocurrency; and 8 WHEREAS, To benefit the State's economy, there is a significant and beneficial requisite 9 to determine how to make Rhode Island the most forward thinking and pro-business state in order 10 to foster a positive economic environment for blockchain and cryptocurrency; now, therefore be it 11 RESOLVED, That a special legislative study commission be and the same is hereby 12 created consisting of five (5) members: one of whom shall be the Rhode Island Secretary of Commerce, or designee, who shall serve as Chair of the commission; one of whom shall be the 13 14 Director of the Department of Business Regulation, or designee; and three (3) of whom shall be members of the public, one of whom shall be a representative from an academic institution with 15 16 experience or knowledge in blockchain technology, to be appointed by the Chair of the 17 Commission, one of whom shall be a representative of a financial institution, to be appointed by the Speaker of the House, and one of whom shall be a representative with experience in federal 18 19 securities law, to be appointed by the President of the Senate.

1	In making appointments to the study commission, the appointing authorities shall strive
2	to ensure that the study commission membership is diverse in educational background, ethnicity,
3	race, sex, and geographic residency.
4	The purpose of said commission shall be to:
5	Review data and information on the scope of blockchain and cryptocurrency
6	throughout the country;
7	Determine the current status of blockchain and cryptocurrency in relation to
8	related laws in this State;
9	• Study non-fungible tokens, including the use, prevalence, function, and current
10	regulation of non-fungible tokens;
11	Solicit ideas and opinions from industry experts; and
12	Compile an overview of potential legislation with recommendations on which
13	legislation will help make this State the most forward thinking and probusiness climate state for
14	blockchain and cryptocurrency and foster a positive economic environment for blockchain and
15	cryptocurrency.
16	Forthwith upon passage of this resolution, the Chair shall call the first meeting of the
17	study commission.
18	A majority of the members of the study commission constitutes a quorum for the purpose
19	of meeting and conducting business.
20	Vacancies in said commission shall be filled in like manner as the original appointment.
21	The membership of said commission shall receive no compensation for their services, but
22	receive reimbursement for expenses incurred in attending meetings of the study commission and
23	for travel incident thereto, in accordance with the comprehensive travel regulations promulgated
24	by the department of finance and administration and approved by the attorney general and
25	reporter.
26	All departments and agencies of the state shall furnish such advice and information,
27	documentary and otherwise, to said commission and its agents as is deemed necessary or
28	desirable by the commission to facilitate the purposes of this resolution.
29	The study commission shall meet at a time and place and at a frequency determined by
30	the Chair but no less than four (4) times per calendar year. Except for the first meeting of the
31	study commission, all other meetings of the study commission, including emergency meetings,
32	are held at the call of the Chair with written notice given to all study commission members.
33	The study commission may conduct regular or special meetings by electronic or other
34	means pursuant to the open meetings act; and

1	The study commission shall agree upon any findings and recommendations by a majority
2	vote of the total membership of the study commission; now, therefore be it
3	RESOLVED, That the commission shall submit an interim progress report of its findings
4	and recommendations to the General Assembly no later than January 5, 2026, and shall submit a
5	final report of its findings and recommendations to the Secretary of Commerce, the General
6	Treasurer, and the General Assembly, no later than January 5, 2027, and shall expire on February
7	5, 2027; and be it further
8	RESOLVED, The final report must include:
9	Data and information on the scope of blockchain and cryptocurrency throughout
10	the country;
11	The current status of blockchain and cryptocurrency in relation to related laws in
12	this State; and
13	• Recommended legislative proposals to encourage a positive economic
14	environment for blockchain and cryptocurrency in this State; and be it further
15	RESOLVED, That the required reports may be submitted electronically, and must be
16	posted on the Department of Commerce and the Department of Business Regulation's website in
17	a publicly accessible place.
