It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 31-17-5.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-17 entitled "Right-Of-
- 2 Way" is hereby amended to read as follows:

#### 3 <u>31-17-5.1. Penalties.</u>

- 4 Any person who violates any provision of §§ 31-17-1 31-17-5, pertaining to the right-
- 5 of-way of pedestrians, upon conviction, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than seventy-
- 6 five (\$75.00) subject to the fines enumerated in § 31-41.1-4.
- 7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
