It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

| 4 | STATE-OWNED AND OPERATED PRINTING FACILITIES PREFERENCE ACT |
| 5 | <u>42-167-1. Short title.</u> |
| 6 | This chapter shall be known and may be cited as "State-Owned and Operated Printing |
| 7 | Facilities Preference". |
| 8 | 42-167-2. Use of state-owned/operated printing facilities. |
| 9 | Any state agency, state institution of higher education, and quasi-public agency which |
| 10 | engages in the printing of more than fifty (50) copies of a contract, publication, brochure, mail |
| 11 | piece, notice, and/or promotional material shall use an existing state-owned/operated print |
| 12 | shop/facility as long as said state-owned/operated print shop/facility is capable of processing and |
| 13 | manufacturing the aforementioned materials. |
| 14 | SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage. |

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE AFFAIRS AND GOVERNMENT -- STATE-OWNED AND OPERATED PRINTING FACILITIES PREFERENCE ACT

1 This act would require, that any state agency, state institution of higher education, and

2 quasi-public agency that engages in printing more than fifty (50) copies of a contract, publication,

3 brochure, notice, or promotional material, to use a state-owned or operated print shop capable of

4 processing the material.

This act would take effect upon passage.
