RELATING TO HEALTH AND SAFETY -- CONSENT TO MEDICAL AND SURGICAL CARE

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 23-4.6 of the General Laws entitled "Consent to Medical and Surgical Care" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

23-4.6-2. Consent to hospice care.

- 4 (a) A patient, recommended for hospice services shall have the right to have a caregiver
- 5 present when hospice services are explained to the patient prior to the patient consenting to hospice
- 6 <u>services.</u>

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- 7 (b) If practical, the patient's caregiver shall be present whenever any medical decisions are
- 8 <u>discussed by the hospice healthcare team with the patient.</u>
- 9 (c) Prior to a patient consenting to hospice services, the patient's caregiver shall be provided
- 10 with all information regarding the patient's medication and treatment and how entering hospice is
- 11 <u>anticipated to effect the prescribed medication and treatment.</u>
- 12 (d) A hospice patient shall have access to visiting nurse care at home and not be excluded
- from those services because of income or age limitations.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

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EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

1	This act would require that an individual's caregiver be present when healthcare decisions
2	are discussed with the hospice team. It would also prevent a denial of home hospice care because
3	of age or income.
4	This act would take effect upon passage.
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
