6	WHEREAS, Born in the City of Providence, Ann Davis was the eldest daughter of the
7	late F. Sheldon and Gertrude Davis, the sister of Elizabeth Alfonso and the late Gertrude Audet,

16	Luke and Elizabeth, who were the light of her life; and
17	WHEREAS, For many years, Mrs. McCaffrey was an elementary and secondary special
18	education teacher in the Warwick Public Schools and was later a member of the RI Retired
19	Teachers' Association; and
20	WHEREAS, Devoted to her faith, Mrs. McCaffrey was a life-long communicant of St.

Benedict Church. In addition, she was a member of the National Society Daughters of the
