It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 45-19-16.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 45-19 entitled "Relief of

- 2 Injured and Deceased Fire Fighters and Police Officers" is hereby amended to read as follows:

45-19-16.1. Presumption for heart disease and hypertension. . .

4	(a) Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, any
5	firefighter or police officer, as defined in § 45-19-1, who is unable to perform the duties required
6	thereof because of an impairment of health caused by heart disease, stroke, or hypertension is
7	presumed to have suffered an in-the-line-of duty injury/disability, unless the contrary can be proven
8	by clear and convincing evidence; and the firefighter or police officer shall be entitled to all benefits
9	provided for in chapters 19, 21, 21.2, and 21.3 of this title.
10	(b) This presumption shall not apply to firefighters or police officers hired after July 1,
11	2023 2025, in the following situations:
12	(1) If a physical examination was conducted at the time the firefighter or police officer was

- hired and the examination revealed that person was suffering from heart disease or hypertension. 13
- 14 (2) If the firefighter or police officer had regularly or habitually used tobacco products
- 15 during the five (5) years prior to any diagnosis of heart disease or hypertension or suffering a stroke.
- 16 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

RELATING TO TOWNS AND CITIES -- RELIEF OF INJURED AND DECEASED FIRE FIGHTERS AND POLICE OFFICERS

This act would add police officers to fire fighters who are unable to perform their duties as
a result of heart disease, stroke or hypertension, to be presumed to have suffered an in-the-line-ofduty disability, unless the police officer was hired after July 1, 2025, and there is clear and
convincing evidence that the police officer suffered the condition at the time of hire or regularly
used tobacco products for the five (5) years prior to a diagnosis.
This act would take effect upon passage.
