It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 42-28.6 of the General Laws entitled "Law Enforcement Officers'
2 Due Process, Accountability, and Transparency Act" is hereby amended by adding thereto the
3 following section:

4 **42-28.6-19. Prohibition against hiring immigration and customs (I.C.E.) officers.**

5 (a) A law enforcement agency, as defined by § 42-164-2, shall not employ any
6 individual who was hired as a sworn officer of the United States Immigration and Customs
7 Enforcement Agency on or after January 20, 2025.

8 (b) This section applies prospectively only and does not apply to any individual
9 hired by the agency prior to the effective date of this section.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on October 1, 2026

- 1 This act would prohibit any law enforcement agencies in the state from hiring any
- 2 individual who was hired as a sworn officer of the United States Immigration and Customs
- 3 enforcement Agency on or after January 20, 2025 and would apply prospectively to an individual
- 4 hired on or after October 1, 2026.
- 5 This act would take effect on October 1, 2026
