It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 3-7 of the General Laws entitled "Retail Licenses" is hereby
- 2 amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>3-7-16.10. Class SE license.</u>
- A city or town may issue a Special Events (SE) license which shall allow any retail
- 5 <u>business or nonprofit organization to offer alcoholic beverages for sale at retail at, or as part of</u>
- 6 the consideration for admission to an event to be held at its premises. Such events shall not be
- 7 <u>held more often than one day in each calendar month. The alcoholic beverages for such events</u>
- 8 may be purchased from a Class A licensee in the same city or town, notwithstanding any other
- 9 provision of this chapter.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
