It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 7-16 of the General Laws entitled "The Rhode Island Limited
Liability Company Act" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

7-16-77. Continuation of certain limited liability company powers. – (a) Any limited
liability company dissolved in any manner pursuant to this chapter, or whose certificate of

5 <u>organization or certificate of registration is revoked pursuant to this chapter, or whose authority to</u>

6 transact business is revoked pursuant to this chapter, shall continue to exist for five (5) years after

the date of the dissolution or revocation for the purpose of enabling it to settle and close its

8 affairs, to dispose of and convey its property, to discharge its liabilities, and to distribute its

9 assets, but not for the purpose of continuing the business for which it was organized. The

members have power to take any action that is appropriate to carry out the purposes of this

11 <u>section.</u>

12 (b) Upon the death of the sole member of a limited liability company, unless otherwise

authorized in the articles of organization or the operating agreement, all affairs, disposition, and

14 distribution of assets and property, contracts, discharge of liabilities, shall be in accordance with

15 <u>§33-1-1 et seq.</u>

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
