Possession of feminine hygiene products. 4 (a) A student, while on school property or at a school-related event or activity, may 5 possess and use over-the-counter products to treat menstrual cramps or vaginal yeast infections without a physician's or parent's note. 6 7 (b) Nothing in this section shall make the school district or its personnel liable for any damages under this section. 8 9 (c) The school district may encourage schools to educate pupils on the safe use of over-10 the-counter medications. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage. 11
