# RELATING TO BUSINESSES AND PROFESSIONS - LICENSURE OF INTERPRETERS FOR THE DEAF

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 5-71 of the General Laws entitled "Licensure of Interpreters for the
- 2 Deaf" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>5-71-19. Impartiality involving family members and children.</u>
- 4 No family member who is under the age of eighteen (18) years of age may work or
- 5 volunteer interpreting for any deaf or hard-of-hearing patients or clients, in in-patient and out-
- 6 patient medical facilities, including mental health and behavioral health facilities. Any medical
- 7 service providers found in violation of this section, will be responsible for such fines and any
- 8 other disciplinary actions determined by rules and regulations promulgated by the Rhode Island
- 9 department of health.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
