It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 28-9.3 of the General Laws entitled "Certified School Teachers"
- 2 Arbitration" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 **28-9.3-17. Continuance of contractual provisions.**
- 4 All contractual provisions contained in a collective bargaining agreement, entered into
- 5 pursuant to the provisions of this chapter, shall continue until such time as a successor agreement
- 6 has been reached between the parties, excluding contractual provisions that limit layoffs or
- 7 <u>layoffs pursuant to § 16-13-6.</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. Chapter 28-9.4 of the General Laws entitled "Municipal Employees"
- 9 Arbitration" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 10 **28-9.4-20.** Continuance of contractual provisions.
- All contractual provisions contained in a collective bargaining agreement, entered into
- pursuant to the provisions of this chapter, shall continue until such time as a successor agreement
- has been reached between the parties, excluding contractual provisions that limit layoffs.
- SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO LABOR AND LABOR RELATIONS -- ARBITRATION -- CONTINUANCE OF CONTRACTUAL PROVISIONS

This act would require that the contractual provisions contained in an otherwise expired collective bargaining agreement with certified school teachers and municipal employees would continue until a successor agreement has been reached between the parties.

This act would take effect upon passage.
