It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 42-9-19 of the General Laws in Chapter 42-9 entitled "Department

of Attorney General" is hereby amended to read as follows:

42-9-19. Acceptance of settlements -- Attorney General settlement restricted

The attorney general is hereby authorized and empowered to accept in the name of the

state any settlement resulting from a multi-state initiative. Such settlement proceeds shall be

7 transferred to the general treasurer for deposit in the general fund. The general treasurer shall

8 transfer ten percent (10%) twenty-five percent (25%) of such proceeds, up to sixty-five thousand

dollars (\$65,000) in any fiscal year, to the "attorney general multi-state initiative account." The

10 restricted account shall be used solely to pay for any fees or membership dues associated with

11 multi-state initiatives.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
