It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 5-40 of the General Laws entitled "Physical Therapists" is hereby
- 2 amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 <u>5-40-23. Physical therapy in a school setting.</u>

- 4 <u>A physical therapist licensed under this chapter may perform physical therapy services</u>
- 5 without a prescription or referral, when providing physical therapy services in a school setting to
- 6 <u>a student in accordance with the provisions of the student's individualized education plan (IEP) or</u>
- 7 individualized family service plan (IFSP).
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
