1 SECTION 1. Section 25-2-46 of the General Laws in Chapter 25-2 entitled "Days of

2 Special Observance" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 25-2-46. Gold Star Parents Day. Gold Star Family Day.

4 The third Sunday in October in each and every year shall be set aside as a day to be

known as "Rhode Island Gold Star Parents Family Day." This nation and state owe an enormous

debt to those grieving parents who have lost children in war. The day is to be observed by the 6

people of this state with appropriate exercises in public places, and shall cause a display of the

8 state and American flags to be flown at half-staff over the Rhode Island State House to

commemorate this day of remembrance to honor their memory.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
