It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 31-24-27 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-24 entitled "Lighting
  Equipment and Reflectors" is hereby amended to read as follows:

  3 31-24-27. Display of lighted lamps required.

  (a) At all times specified in § 31-24-1, at least two (2) lighted lamps shall be displayed
- one on each side at the front of every motor vehicle other than a motorcycle or motor-driven cycle, except when the vehicle is parked subject to the regulations governing lights on parked vehicles.
- 8 (b) Front lighted lamps displayed in the front of every motor vehicle provided as original
  9 equipment from the manufacturer shall not be replaced by different lamps that project a beam of
  10 light greater than the intensity of the original equipment.
- 11 (c) Violations of this section are subject to fines enumerated in § 31-41.1-4.
- 12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
