4 <u>22-7.4-143. The Rhode Island Purple Heart Trail.</u>

5 The section of highway known as Route 4 and Route 1, which begins in Warwick as Route

6 <u>4 and merges into Route 1 in North Kingstown and further extends to the town of Westerly, shall</u>

- 7 be named The Rhode Island Purple Heart Trail. Provided, this designation shall be coextensive
- 8 with and shall not repeal, revoke, or displace any name or similar designation already given to
- 9 sections or areas of and along the highway, and those names and designations shall remain in effect.
- 10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
