It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Title 42 of the General Laws entitled "STATE AFFAIRS AND 2 GOVERNMENT" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following chapter: 3 CHAPTER 46.1 AUDIO AND VIDEO RECORDINGS 4 5 42-46.1-1. Recordings to be made. 6 (a) Every public school committee of any city, town or regional school district; and every 7 city or town council; and every city or town zoning board of review shall make audio and video 8 recordings of all open meetings and shall transmit the recordings of all open meetings, as defined in chapter 46 of this title, within forty-eight (48) hours of the meeting, to the office of the secretary 9 10 of state. 11 (b) The secretary of state shall post the recordings of all open meetings recorded pursuant 12 to this section on its website within one business day of receipt, and make the recordings available 13 to the public in such format or formats as are commonly used for Internet transmission. 14 (c) This section shall not apply to public bodies whose responsibilities are solely advisory 15 in nature. 16 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
