It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 17-19-30 of the General Laws in Chapter 17-19 entitled "Conduct of
- 2 Election and Voting Equipment, and Supplies" is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 17-19-30. Voters who register by making a mark rather than signature.
- 4 Any voter who has registered by making his or her mark rather than his or her signature,
- 5 or who shall be physically unable to sign his or her name at the time of offering himself or herself
- 6 to vote, shall identify himself or herself with proof of identity as required under § 17-19-24.2. They
- 7 The election officials shall permit the voter to affix the voter's mark on the electronic pollbook in
- 8 their presence and shall record their approval on the electronic pollbook as in other cases.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
