It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 23-1 of the General Laws entitled "Department of Health" is hereby
- 2 amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 23-1-2.1. Medical treatment for home-bound elderly residents.
- 4 The director of the department of health shall develop and administer a program of on-call
- 5 physicians, for each of the state's five (5) counties, who are available to perform in-house visits to
- 6 examine and treat sick elderly residents, over the age of sixty-five (65), who are unable to travel to
- 7 a doctor's office on their own, without assistance.
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

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EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

RELATING TO HEALTH AND SAFETY -- HEALTH DEPARTMENT MEDICAL CARE

This act would require the director of the department of health to develop and administer a program of on-call physicians to make home visits to elderly residents unable to travel to the doctor's office without assistance.

This act would take effect upon passage.

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
