It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 21-28.6 of the General Laws entitled "The Edward O. Hawkins and
- 2 Thomas C. Slater Medical Marijuana Act" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following
- 3 section:
- 4 <u>21-28.6-4.1. Non-discrimination.</u>
- 5 (a) All departments and units of Rhode Island state government, including all public and
- 6 quasi-public agencies, commissions, boards and authorities are prohibited from refusing to hire or
- 7 promote or render any punishment or decision in regards to any person exclusively for their use of
- 8 medical marijuana or their status as a registered patient cardholder.
- 9 (b) All departments and units of Rhode Island state government, including all public and
- 10 quasi-public agencies, commissions, boards and authorities are required to reasonably
- 11 <u>accommodate any employee's or prospective employee's medical marijuana use.</u>
- 12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
