It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 12-17 of the General Laws entitled "Trial" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>12-17-20. Jury nullification as proper argument.</u>
- 4 <u>During any trial on any criminal matter before a jury, counsel for the defendant shall have</u>
- 5 the right to argue that the jury should take into consideration not just the law, but the facts, the
- 6 nature of the charge, and whether the law the defendant is charged with violating is morally
- 7 repugnant, outdated or unfair to the citizenry and those accused of violating the law.
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
