It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 17-25-13 of the General Laws in Chapter 17-25 entitled "Rhode

Island Campaign Contributions and Expenditures Reporting" is hereby amended to read as follows:

#### 17-25-13. Penalties.

- 4 (a) Any person who willfully and knowingly violates the provisions of this chapter shall,
- 5 upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than one thousand dollars
- 6 (\$1,000) per violation.

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- 7 (b) The state board may fine any person or entity who violates the provisions of this chapter
- 8 in an amount not more than one hundred dollars (\$100) per violation.
- 9 (c) Fines, fees and penalties imposed by the state board for violations of this chapter shall
- be paid for by the candidate, officeholder or, the chairperson of the entity against whose campaign
- the fines, fees or penalties have been levied. Fines, fees and penalties levied by the state board
- 12 pursuant to this chapter shall not be paid for from contributions or funds available in a campaign
- 13 account.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
