- 4 On every September 11 in all grades in all public schools, the teachers in charge of the
- 5 room in which each class is held, may allow a brief moment of silence to be observed in memory
- 6 of the tragic events of September 11, 2001.
- 7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
