It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 4-19 of the General Laws entitled "Animal Care" is hereby amended
- 2 by adding thereto the following section:

3 **4-19-23.** Pets for veterans.

- 4 (a) A public animal shelter shall not charge an adoption fee for a dog or cat if the person
- 5 adopting the dog or cat presents to the public animal shelter a current and valid driver's license or
- 6 identification card with the word "veteran" printed on its face pursuant to § 31-10-48.
- 7 (b) A public animal shelter may limit the number of dogs or cats adopted from that public
- 8 <u>animal shelter pursuant to subsection (a) of this section to one dog or cat every six (6) month period.</u>
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO ANIMALS AND ANIMAL HUSBANDRY - ANIMAL CARE

1 This act would waive the adoption fee to adopt a dog or cat from a public animal shelter 2 for a veteran that presents a current and valid driver's license or identification card with the word 3 "veteran" printed on its face.

4 This act would take effect upon passage.
