It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 6-13.1 of the General Laws entitled "Deceptive Trade Practices" is
- 2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>6-13.1-31. Discrimination prohibited.</u>
- 4 <u>It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, partnership, corporation or association to</u>
- 5 <u>discriminate or fail or refuse to engage in business or sell a product or service to include, but not</u>
- 6 <u>be limited to, consumer, banking, insurance and/or professional services, goods or products, to any</u>
- 7 person based on political affiliation, political position, status as an entertainer, or because the person
- 8 <u>engages in any other lawful employment position or occupation.</u>
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
