14	Island, Massachusetts and Connecticut, and had been employed with the former Cunningham &
15	Son's Plumbing and Heating Company. He was also a lifelong member of Local #51 Plumbers

17	WHEREAS, A faithful communicant, Mr. Cunningham was one of the original members
18	of St. Martha's Church in East Providence. He was also an avid sports fan and enjoyed golf and
