## HONORING SUZANNE MAGAZINER ON BEING NAMED THE CHIEF MARSHAL OF THE 2020 BRISTOL 4TH OF JULY PARADE, THE OLDEST 4TH OF JULY CELEBRATION IN AMERICA

WHEREAS, Suzanne Magaziner, a distinguished graduate of Wellesley College, Harvard
Law School, Harvard Business School, and Brown University, has had a long and distinguished
career as a business strategy consultant, beginning with the Boston Consulting Group and later as
a consultant with the international consulting firm she co-founded with her husband, Ira
Magaziner. Since their marriage, they have made Bristol, Rhode Island their home; and

6 WHEREAS, Since retiring, Suzanne has worked tirelessly on behalf of various non-profit 7 organizations, particularly those that assist underserved populations. She currently serves as the 8 Chair of Trinity Repertory, a position she has held since 2014. Prior to that, she served on its 9 Board for more than ten years. Under her guidance and direction, Trinity's work includes the 10 nationally recognized Project Discovery, which has brought 1.5 million school children to low 11 cost performances. Additionally, Trinity has a program for autistic children and adults (TRAIN), 12 which has become a national model for many other artistic organizations; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Magaziner has also served on the Board of Sophia Academy, a private middle school for girls from low-income homes in Providence, for more than a dozen years. She also was a founding board member of the Nowell Leadership Academy, an alternative high school for pregnant, parenting, and at-risk students, and has served on the boards of Roger Williams University, Save the Bay, Save Bristol Harbor, and several schools. Together, she and her husband have made available acreage on their Bristol farm for the East Bay Food Pantry to raise fresh, organic vegetables, and starting in 2020, bees for honey for their clients; and WHEREAS, Ms. Magaziner was the recipient of the 2019 Woman of Wisdom Award
 from Sophia Academy, the 2018 YWCA Woman of Achievement Award, the 2015 Outstanding
 Philanthropic Award from the Rhode Island Chapter of the Association of Fundraising
 Professionals, the 2012 Providence Place Gives Award, and the 2012 Citizens Award from Save
 Bristol Harbor; and

WHEREAS, Suzanne and Ira Magaziner are the proud parents of three children and two
grandchildren: The Honorable Seth Magaziner and his wife Julia McDowell, Jonathan and his
wife Jennifer Doorly Magaziner, the parents of Ronan and Kiernan, and Sarah. Suzanne and Ira
have been a part of the Bristol Fourth of July Parade since 1981; now, therefore be it
