WHEREAS, Captain Mark Turner, son of a World War II veteran, was born in
Greenwich, Connecticut, and was commissioned after graduation from Marquette ROTC. Captain
Turner served our nation with honor and distinction for thirty years as a Naval Officer in the
Maritime Patrol Community. Captain Turner held multiple leadership positions including serving
as the Commanding Officer and Commodore of Airwing Eleven; and

6 WHEREAS, Captain Turner attended the U.S. Naval War College in Newport in 2010 7 and earned a Master's degree in National Security and Strategic Studies. He went on to serve as 8 the Director of the Naval Staff College. He has received numerous awards in recognition of his 9 distinguished career including the James Forrestal Award for Excellence in Strategic Planning, 10 and Rhode Island Society of the Order of the Founders and Patriots Award for Excellence. His 11 military awards include three Legions of Merit, the Defense Service Medal, two Meritorious 12 Service Medals, and four Navy Commendation Medals; and

WHEREAS, After retiring from the Naval Staff College, Captain Turner took a position as a contractor with Netsimco, where he continued to provide support to the mission of the Naval War College. He also began volunteering his time in support of Rogers High School, where he co-created an International Studies and Leadership program teaching students about global issues. He later married Colleen Kiernan, a teacher he worked with at Rogers High School; and

18 WHEREAS, In addition to his wife Colleen, Captain Turner is blessed with three

stepchildren, Gabrielle, a nurse at Rhode Island Hospital, Catherine, a recent graduate of the University of Virginia, and John, a 2020 graduate of Rogers High School. As a member of VFW Post 406, Captain Turner worked on the Committee to bring the Vietnam Memorial Moving Wall to Newport in 2019. His numerous speaking engagements have included speaking at the Pearl Harbor Commemoration, the 9/11 Commemoration, (He was stationed at the Pentagon during the attack), the Newport Memorial Day Remembrance, and he was the Keynote Speaker for the Rogers High School online graduation; now, therefore be it
