| 9  | (2) The president of the senate;  |
| 10 | (3) The majority leader of the house of representatives;  |
| 11 | (4) The majority leader of the senate;  |
| 12 | (5) The minority leader of the house of representatives;  |
| 13 | (6) The minority leader of the senate;  |
| 14 | (7) The finance chair of the house of representatives;  |
| 15 | (8) The finance chair of the senate; and  |
| 16 | (9) Two (2) members of the executive branch as designated by the governor.                          |
| 17 | (c) The joint council shall be activated ninety (90) days after a state of emergency shall be       |
| 18 | declared by executive order or proclamation of the governor, pursuant to the provisions of § 30-15- |

9(b), for the purpose of determining whether the state of emergency has ended and to address the

- 1 <u>restoration of the state's economy, if necessary.</u>
- 2 (d) All determinations made by the joint council shall not become effective until passage
- 3 of a concurrent resolution and/or the necessary statutory relief.
- 4 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
