The provisions of this section shall not apply: 6 7 (1) To an automobile equipped with tires that without any tire air inflation permit vehicle 8 operation for at least fifty (50) miles at speeds up to at least fifty-five (55) miles per hour; or 9 (2) An automobile equipped with a factory installed tire repair and inflation system. (b) A violation of this section shall constitute a misdemeanor. 10 (c) All motor vehicle dealers shall disclose to the buyer in writing whether or not the vehicle 11
