It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 45-2 of the General Laws entitled "General Powers" is hereby
- 2 amended by adding thereto the following section:

#### 3 45-2-68. Local snowstorm communication requirement.

- 4 (a) Every municipality within the State of Rhode Island shall be required to provide notice
- 5 to residents, within at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to any forecasted snowstorm, of street
- 6 parking bans, and trash pickup delays or cancellations, utilizing technological communication
- 7 devices including, but not limited to, electronic, digital media, telephonic or any other method
- 8 <u>available to advise the public.</u>
- 9 (b) Every municipality in the State of Rhode Island shall also provide public parking to
- 10 enable residents to park their automobiles during parking bans, limited, however, to the duration of
- 11 the parking ban plus two (2) hours.
- 12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

1 This act would require every municipality in Rhode Island to provide residents twenty-four 2 (24) hours notice by any electronic or digital means, such as digital media and telephonic, as a 3 result of any forecasted snowstorm regarding street parking bans and trash pickup delays or 4 cancellations. Towns and cities would also be required to provide public parking for any residents 5 unable to park their vehicle at their residence as a result of a parking ban. 6 This act would take effect upon passage.
