SERVICE TO ST. JUDE CHILDREN'S RESEARCH HOSPITAL

1 WHEREAS, Solomon A. Solomon, Chairman of the Business Administration
2 Department at the Community College of Rhode Island and member of the State Judicial
3 Nominating Commission is honored for his outstanding commitment to the Rhode Island Chapter
4 of the St. Jude Children's Research Hospital; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Solomon, named 1997 Member of the Year of this Chapter, is a
6 graduate of Hope High School, Bryant College and the University of Rhode Island, and served
7 his country in the United States Army from 1950 to 1952; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Solomon and his beloved wife, Lillian have three children, Patricia
9 Lucarelli, Cecile Roberti and Michael Solomon. They are the grandparents of five wonderful
10 grandchildren; and

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Solomon has owned and operated the Six Corners Cleaners and Tailors,
12 the Six Corners Department Store and Solomon Realty Company. He has been involved in
13 education from 1964 when he began as a Business Teacher with the Dighton Rehoboth Regional
14 High School. He moved in 1967 to the Community College of Rhode Island as Coordinator of the
15 Retail Management Program. He currently serves CCRI as Chairman of the Business
16 Administration Department and plans on retiring this year; and

17 WHEREAS, Always seeming to find the time for community service, Mr. Solomon
18 served numerous organizations, either as an officer or member, including; the East Providence
19 School Committee, the Executive Board of the Rhode Island Association of School Committees,
20 the Executive Board of the Bryant College Alumni Association, the Bryant College National

1 Alumni Council, Tau Epsilon Fraternity, the CCRI Foundation, Bristol County, Massachusetts,
2 Dighton-Rehoboth, and New England Business Teachers' Associations, the East Providence
3 Chamber of Commerce, the Providence Rotary Club, the American Marketing Association, the
4 Rhode Island, New England and National Associations of Admissions Officers, Troop 88 Boy
5 Scouts of America, the East Providence Boys Club, the Heart Fund, the Knights of Columbus and
6 many, many more; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Solomon founded the Greater Rhode Island Chapter of ALSAC and has
8 been personally responsible for statewide organization, public relations and the recruitment of all
9 volunteer personnel for a 10 year period. He was appointed as a National Committee Member to
10 the ALSAC/St. Jude Board of Directors in 1998, and served as National Chairman at the St. Jude
11 Children's Research Hospital's National Convention in 1997; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Solomon has received numerous awards in recognition of his
13 commitment to serving others. These awards include the National DECA Outstanding Service
14 Award, the State Employees Charitable Appeal Chairmen Citation Award, the CCRI/RIJC
15 Alumni Recognition Award, Rhode Island Business Educator of the Year Award, the Outstanding
16 Educator of America in both 1972 and 1974, and many, many more; now, therefore be it

17 RESOLVED, That this House of Representatives of the State of Rhode Island and
18 Providence Plantations hereby honors Mr. Solomon Anthony Solomon. The success of the State
19 of Rhode Island, the strength of our communities and the overall vitality of American society

21 selfless efforts have served to remind us of the humane and noble purpose that is embedded in
